At Centro Fox we work to be the cradle of leadership for each of our visitors, from the smallest to the oldest.


OUR MISSION IS:

LICEO CERVANTINO CAMPUS CENTRO FOX STARTS!

Centro Fox, in collaboration with Incarnate Word University and its subsidiary, the Liceo Cervantino Institute, has launched the Bivalent Baccalaureate in Computer Science for the student community in the central region of the country. The Centro Fox facilities, which house the first Presidential Library and Museum in Latin America, will be the official location for this outstanding educational project.

In October 2023, the first anniversary of the inauguration of this high school was celebrated, with the presence of the former president of Mexico and president of Centro Fox, Lic. Vicente Fox Quesada, the Secretary of Education of Guanajuato, Mtro. Jorge Enrique Hernández Meza, Mrs. Marta Sahagún de Fox, President of the Vamos México Foundation, and the highest authorities of Incarnate Word University.

The alliance between these institutions responds to the need to offer a quality high school educational project, which also offers great benefits such as:

- Bilingual education.
- Better opportunities for academic development.
- Cultural and sports workshops.
- Extensive links with companies.
- Complete preparation for entrepreneurship, to integrate into working life or continue with higher level studies, in public or private institutions.
- Direct entry to the Incarnate Word University Bajío campus.
- The opportunity to access educational and cultural exchanges to San Antonio, Texas in the United States.



Activities and main results for the year 2023.

We carry out the **2023 Summer Courses**, with **100 children**, for 3 weeks of crafts, environment, nature and learning activities. With the permanent collaboration of the **Centro Fox Museum** and Library, and support from **SFR Environment and SFR Firefighters** for the activities, in addition to a visit to the Guanajuato Bicentenario Park and a closing gathering.

We received 6 UCI students at Centro Fox for their 3-week experience in the PPUD program, with the aim of proposing improvements for the program; They accompanied the team to learn about the Extramuros Program in the communities, and lived the experience of the Trip to México City for the winning school of the school year.

We held 4 camps with PAN Gto. (political party) and Juventudes Gto., receiving more than 100 young people per camp, for a stay of 2 days and 1 night, full of leadership activities.

We traveled to México City with the school that won the **2023 Líderes en Acción Award in its 7th edition** with Secondary 22 Mario Aguirre Casas. We visited the following sites: Zócalo, National Palace, Cathedral), Chapultepec Castles, Chapultepec Zoo/Ajolote Museum, Los Pinos: "Dinos en los Pinos" exhibition.







ACHIEVED GOALS

We are a space of knowledge and identity where the user is offered information and documentation related to the areas of Centro Fox, from leadership to education, Mexican history, national literature, etc.

We are the first **Presidential Library in Mexico**, which offers a retrospective of one of the six years that changed the history of the country, that of **Vicente Fox Quesada**, from 2000 to 2006.

Children, young people and adults have free and unlimited access to all kinds of library services and information, as well as recreational activities. Our bases are to develop, provide and guide library and cultural services to the communities in general, so that they can freely acquire and increase knowledge in all branches of knowledge.











CENTER OF POSSIBILITIES

The **University of California in San Diego (UCSD)**, in alliance for **11 years** with Centro Fox and **Fundación Vamos México**, carried out the creation of **the Center of Possibilities** in San Cristóbal, Guanajuato.

This great project provides a considerable impact to the youth and families of the communities and cities surrounding Centro Fox. The truly extraordinary thing about this educational project is that some of these classes will be directed and taught by young leaders of the Vamos México Foundation program., "ALAS" (Activating Leaders in Social Action), who graduated as instructors trained by UCSD. "ALAS" is a leadership and community projects program that Vamos México has been carrying out since 2016.







